#### SOCIAL HOST STATUTE - ARS 4-241.Q

A person who is at least eighteen years of age and whis is an occupant of an unlicensed premises is guilty of a class 1 misdemeanor if the person knowingly hosts on the unlicensed premises a gathering of two or more persons who are under the legal drinking age and if the person knows that one or more of the persons under the egal drinking age are in possession of or consuming solithous liquor on the unlicensed premises.







